



PRIVACY POLICY

1. PURPOSE

We believe privacy is a right, not a feature. Where it's possible to work with us anonymously, we encourage it. The purpose of this document is to explain what personal data Foresight collects in order to run our programs, why, and how we protect it.

2. SCOPE

Website visitors, donors, fellows, and event attendees. Applies globally, with specific provisions for California (CCPA) and EU/EEA (GDPR) residents.

3. POLICY

We collect name, email, phone, address, financial information (donations), employment and education history, IP address, and website activity (Google Analytics). We use this data to process donations, respond to inquiries, and run programs and events. We do not sell personal data. We share it only when required by law or with service providers bound by data protection agreements. We retain data until deletion is requested or until legal and audit obligations are met.
